



JOHNNY YOUNG TALENT SCHOOL-MILL PARK- INFORMATION SHEET

Welcome to the Johnny Young Talent School -Mill Park-. Our aim is to provide a pleasant and welcoming environment for your child to explore their interest in singing, dancing and performing. We hope you all enjoy your time with us and find it a beneficial and rewarding experience. Below is some helpful information to help make this possible.

OUR FRIENDLY STAFF

Our School Principal is Sally Fellowes. Sally conducts all our Singing Classes including the Private Singing lessons and all Tiny Tots classes. Liz Federle and Carly Lagana teach Modern Jazz and Tap classes. Acrobatics and Hip Hop classes are taught by Carly Lagana and Beginners Ballet and all Youngstars Ballet, Modern Jazz and Tap by Kim Oikawa. Marilyn Langmead and Judith Fellowes are at reception.

LOCATION FOR CLASSES

All classes are held at Mill Park Secondary College Junior Campus, Moorhead Drive, MILL PARK. Telephone 9437-8011.(Off Childs Road into Redleap Avenue and 1st left after 2nd roundabout - Ist driveway on left into Carpark) Entry to class venue is via Gymnasium doors into foyer waiting area. Parents/Friends are not permitted in the classroom during lessons as this distracts the class. All children are to wait in foyer until the teachers collect them for class.

****NB** For safety reason, no children are permitted to wait for their parents outside the venue so please escort them to the foyer at the commencement of class and pick them up from the foyer on completion of class.**

RECEPTION DESK

On arrival for your child's 1st lesson please make yourself known to the staff at the front desk and they will provide any assistance necessary. Children are requested to wait in the foyer until the teacher collects them for class. Class rolls are marked in the class by the teacher so it is not necessary for you to check in at the front desk before each lesson. Newsletters and information are handed to students in class and you should check at front desk if your child is absent whether one was missed. Please check noticeboards weekly as latest newsletter will be displayed along with any other important upcoming dates. Payments can be made and singlet tops etc. picked up from the reception desk which is open at the following times:

Wed 5-7pm, Thu 4.30-6.30pm, Fri 5.30-7pm and Sat 9-3pm.

CLASS TIME AND DURATION

Your child's class times and commencement details are included in the covering letter. Please be punctual and parents of Tiny Tots please ensure your child has been to the toilet(located in Gymnasium) just prior to coming to class. This will avoid disruption to classes and provide quality time for your child in their lessons.

DAILY CONTACT NOS.

Parent's are invited to remain in the foyer during class and siblings are welcome to wait with you in the foyer but please ensure they play in a quiet manner or have something of a quiet nature to keep them occupied. They must not run around or enter any other rooms.

It is also permissible to drop students off in the foyer at the beginning of class and pick them up(once again from the foyer) after class, perhaps while you do some shopping etc. For these parents, in particular those with children in Tiny Tots classes, please make sure that you have left a current contact no. for you for the duration of the lesson ie.mobile phone at the front desk. This is just a precautionary measure in case your child feels sick.

ADDITIONAL RULES IN CLASS

Children are requested to be punctual and quiet and attentive in class in order to cause minimum disruption to classes. No mobile phones are to be turned on or touched during classes. No chewing gum or food is allowed but please provide your child with a drink bottle of water to bring to class.

CONCERTS

The end of year concerts are held at the George Wood Performing Arts Theatre in Kalinda Road, Ringwood (located on the Yarra Valley Grammar School Campus). Concerts are held at the end of December each year. All students are required to participate in these concerts as a part of their learning.

STAGE REHEARSAL

Stage rehearsal for your child will be held on prior to the end of year concert at the theatre and it is compulsory for all students to attend. Any student who does not attend this stage rehearsal (for whatever the reason), will not be allowed to perform on the concerts.

PHOTO DAY

A compulsory photo day is held 1-2 weeks prior to the end of year concert each year at the Talent School. Photo envelopes will be distributed prior to this day.

COSTUME FEE

All students who are enrolled at the Johnny Young Talent School on Week 3 of Block 3, will be expected to pay a Costume Fee for concert costumes and Block 3 & 4 fees in full and perform in the End of Year Concert. At this stage of the school year we commence working on concert items and sewing of concert costumes.
